### ABOUT THE PROJECT

Daniel Gwirtzman Dance Company, a New York-based nonprofit performing and teaching company, is creating an educational digital resource, *Dance With Us*, centered around the production of a series of new films. Geared toward a general viewership this multi-faceted project seeks to demystify concert dance by explaining ways to view dance and discussing how dances are made. Through performance and studio footage the resource aims to teach people how to think and speak about dance. The films will present favorite dances from the Company's repertory, provide wellness best practices, define dance's concepts, and illuminate dance histories. The project entails multiple shoots beginning in early August followed by a post-production period. The films will launch mid-Fall.

### ABOUT THE POSITION

The Company seeks a videographer to collaborate with and help with the shooting of these films within the first two weeks of August in Ithaca, NY. This paid position will involve filming multiple dances in both indoor and outdoor locations in the Ithaca region. We are looking to work with someone who has experience filming dance/movement, sports, or other live action. Having one's own transportation is necessary as shoots will take place in various locations. We will adhere to current guidelines regarding social distancing in all aspects of the production.
